NOT FROM: encyclopedias, automobile advertisements, questionnaires, textbooks

The Article Review should NOT be a summary of the article (which is stapled to your paper), but rather a response to the article you have chosen.

The Article Review should convey the reason why the article was written; this may be the who, what, when, where, why, and how.

You may want to answer the following as a guide:

- What is important about this _____(research, person, place, trend, etc.)
- Why was the research done and/or who paid for it?
- Why did the accident occur, etc?
- Of what interest is it to you?
- How does it apply?
- How does it apply to you or your family?
- Is reading this article going to change your behavior?
- What does it mean for the community? Etc......
