

Criteria for Storytelling Tile Project

Craftsmanship:

- Student uses the additive process somewhere on their relief tile.
- Student uses the subtractive process somewhere on their relief tile.
- Student made a tile that is at least 8 in. x 8 in. or multiple (2) smaller tiles, at least 6 in. x 6 in.
- There are no chips or cracks in the finished tile.
- Student has an indent in the back allowing the tile to be hung on a wall.
- Student used their printed stamp or a pen or pencil to sign their name onto the back of the tile.

Participation:

- Student utilized class time to complete their project.
- Student had their camera on and showed their work throughout the project.
- Student logged their ideas and progress into the Storytelling Tile Archive.
- Student is willing to ask questions and share any thoughts or ideas, when asked.
